



ABOUT THE CLUB: The Safeguard Global ACT Brumbies play Super Rugby at an International level plus facilitate local competitions featuring 7 major divisions, over 100 senior teams, 260 junior teams, school-based programs, and registered players. Founded in 1996, our world-class high-performance program is regarded as one of the best programs in world rugby and has helped the club recruit players from all corners of the globe whilst never neglecting the local talent. Local talent from Canberra and the surrounding region has been a hallmark of the club since its inception in 1996. Indeed, the number of local players who have made a name for themselves in the colours of the Brumbies, and before that their predecessors, is huge. To continue to contract and retain local talent, support players Wallabies/Wallaroos journeys and facilitate local competitions and growing pathway programs, ACT Brumbies require the support of several Fundraising efforts, including the annual event – Women in Business.

SILENT AUCTION AND BALLOT BIDDING: As part of the fundraising activities, a silent auction will be run on the day in conjunction with helping hand group, <https://helpinghand.com.au/>.

For the 2024 Women in Business luncheon, a Ballot Bidding system will be used. Instructions are below:

1. Find the Ballot Bidding form on your table which lists all of the amazing items on offer today.
2. To place a bid please fill out the required information on the top of the form and place your desired one time only maximum bid amount in the space next to the item/s you like.
3. Once your form is completed, please hold it up in the air and one of our helpers will collect it from you.

The highest maximum bidder will be the winner of the item. Purchasers may also be successful on more than one of their bids in which they are bound to purchase all they have successfully won. The items designated as 'one only available' will be sold to the highest bidder only and the items designated as 'multiples available' will be offered in order from the highest bidder down (until the limited quantities are sold).

Items can be paid for at the luncheon and delivery can be arranged for a fee.

ACT BRUMBIES EXPERIENCE ITEMS TERMS AND CONDITIONS: The silent auction items that are provided by the ACT Brumbies and the Terms and Conditions are outlined below for each item, understanding that no item can be transferred for cash, used as a public promotion, or sold on to a third party without the written consent of the ACT Brumbies. With all ACT Brumbies experiences, winners will be provided a letter with the item description and contact details. It is up to the purchaser to get in contact with ACT Brumbies to activate their experience/item by September 2025.

Lot 5 BBQ with the Brums: Along with 4 guests, you will be welcomed to a BBQ at ACT Brumbies HQ with the Safeguard Global ACT Brumbies playing squad. Two weeks' notice at minimum and dates will be provided to the item owner depending on player training schedules. Player available may vary. Cancellation of the experience from the item owner within 7 working days of the experience may result in a forfeit of the experience or a credit may be applied should another suitable date not be applicable. Lot 6 Match Day Experience: The sideline access includes viewing the teams warm up from the dugout and taking part of guard of honour. Match of your choice pending due to availability, please wear weather appropriate clothing with current ACT Brumbies branded merchandise or plain clothing with no logos. Once the experience has been finalised, a suite will be provided with light canape catering for up to 12 guests, with a beverage package including non-alcoholic, beer and wine (no spirits) with a max beverage spend of \$500.

Lot 24 Sideline Viewing Front Row Access. From the sidelines, you and a guest get an up-close and personal view of the players and the action on the field, witnessing the development of plays and the incredible skill of the athletes as they navigate the game. From the sidelines, enjoy the intense energy, hear the crunch of the tackles, the shouts of the coaches, and the roar of the crowd, feeling the palpable excitement of the game. Preferred match is pending availability and minimum 7 working days required with written contact from item owner. Seats will be provided and located to the side of the dugout. The location is out in the elements, should the item owner like to reschedule due to weather or due to other situations out of average control, please advise the ACT Brumbies in writing and the ACT Brumbies will do their best to find an alternative date, however guest may risk forfeiting experience or will be provided a different experience depending on their calendar. Please wear weather appropriate clothing with current ACT Brumbies branded merchandise or plain clothing with no logos. No external food or drinks permitted. Winner of item to stay within the barriers, no access to field at any time without being escorted by an ACT Brumbies staff member.

Lot 26 Season Open Box: This open box is for an 8-seater open box, located in the West side of GIO Stadium. The box will be available to client(s) for the entire 2025 Super Rugby Pacific Season home games at GIO Stadium, including finals. The open boxes are uncatered (do not include food and/or beverages) however this can be easily arranged via the stadium caterer at a cost to the client. The box must be arranged no later than one week before first match of the season, should catering be required.

Lot 27 School visit from Brumbies HPU: The High-Performance Unit consists of a team of coaches and physios, who will come to the purchaser's location of choice (ACT Brumbies approved ACT school or sporting club) for a specialised training session. Availability pending on coach's schedule. Once a suitable date has been agreed on between ACT Brumbies, purchaser and the location, up to three (3) HPU staff will attend and provide a session for the group of up to 30 people max, including coaching session, physio session and S&C session. 60 mins approximately. Footballs and other equipment will be provided. One available.

Lot 31 Kicking Lesson: Get ahead with your kicking and conversions with a one-on-one kicking lesson with a current world class ACT Brumbies kicker. Stats are currently approx. overall 80% success rate for ACT Brumbies kickers (conversions and penalty kicks). A one on one, 30-minute kicking lesson on the Brumbies main field for the purchaser. Player will be confirmed closer to the confirmed date and will be selected at ACT Brumbies discretion. If the experience is forced to be cancelled before the experience starts due to weather, another date can be selected, if the weather changes throughout the experience, rescheduling will be at the discretion of the ACT Brumbies however may not occur depending on the length of the session. Should the purchaser cancel or require rescheduling within 7 days of the experience, the purchaser may have to forfeit the experience. ACT Brumbies will not be responsible for any injuries that may occur during this experience or any post-experience injuries or soreness. Please exercise at your own health standards and suited pace.
